FAQ

- **When does IVLP start and how long does it last?**

The program runs from November 20th and **includes only 5 meetings.** Therefore, **IVLP** can easily be combined with study or work.

- **Where is IVLP?**

All meetings will be hybrid: In-person for Israelis and people who are based in Israel/online for other participants from other countries. As a hybrid program, participants can be easily accessed by anyone with a computer/smart device and an internet connection

- **Who can sign up?**

IVLP - The suggested project involves networking, training workshops and educational sessions to combat online hate speech and disinformation, aimed at Jews and Arabs who live in Israel. participants aged 15+.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

1st Meeting : Welcome and Introduction

Monday, 20.11, 18:00-20:30

Introductory Session: Networking; Introduction to the program (staff, participants, schedule); the importance of stopping online hate speech, and local challenges. (In-person); Ideas for the group project.

2nd Meeting: Training Session

Participants will be introduced to IHRA's working definition of antisemitism, online hate speech, and community guidelines of the leading social media platforms. Participants will then learn how to identify, monitor, and report content on social media; Participants will Learn how to detect and flag on leading social media platforms.

3rd Meeting: Advanced cyber and monitoring

Monday, 18.12, 18:00-19:30

A meeting with a keynote speaker: a special event meant to provide participants with insights into different aspects of hate speech (e.g., conspiracy theories during COVID-19, emotionally coping with exposure to online hate speech, advocating for civil speech, cybersecurity).
